

Summer Reading Work for ENTERING THE 7th GRADE

For Roman numeral I: do this for both books read (all three for accelerated English)

For Roman numeral II: do this for only one of the choices

For Roman numeral III: to be completed in class, not over the summer

I. Keep a reader's response notebook. (I suggest getting a spiral notebook or using your computer. Staying organized will help you!) **DUE THE SECOND DAY OF CLASS!!**

- A. There will be a **MINIMUM** of four entries. You can write more if you choose.
- B. After reading about $\frac{1}{4}$ of the book, write an entry. Each entry will have the following elements:
 1. Chapters read and DATE
**Example, you would write at the top: Introduction-Chapter 5
June 13
 2. Two paragraphs
 - a. Paragraph One: A summary of the plot. What is going on in the story? Who are the characters? What are they like? What is the conflict?
 - b. Paragraph Two: A personal response. This is your opinion. Tell what you like and dislike about the book so far. Tell what you think will happen. Tell what you think about the characters' responses to certain situations.

****NOTES: This does not have to be typed. This assignment should reflect journaling. If you prefer typing, that is fine, but it is not required.

II. Project: You choose only one of your novels to complete a digital project. This project is due the third day of class. **CHOOSE ONE** of the following options.

- A. PowerPoint Presentation of the characters.
- B. PowerPoint Presentation covering the plot...a summary.
- C. Podcast: Record yourself performing a radio broadcast of the events.
- D. PowerPoint Presentation: book analysis.

**Refer to the rubrics for specifics on these choices.

III. Write a paper on one of your novels. (**DURING CLASS; NOT TO BE COMPLETED DURING THE SUMMER.**)
