

POWERPOINT PRESENTATION OF CHARACTERS---110 points total

*Minimum of 12 slides.

Slide 1: Title slide (4 points)

1. title of book
2. author of book
3. title of your presentation
4. student's name

Slides 2-11: Character Slides (10 points each slide: 100 points total)

1. Title: name of character
2. Bulleted List: include descriptions of character traits...should NOT include physical characteristics. MINIMUM of 5 per slide
3. Graphic: a portrait of character or a picture that represents that character

Slide 12: Conclusion Slide (1 point for title; 5 points for rating: 6 points total)

1. Title: Slide must have a title...you decide what it is
2. Rating: Did you like the book? Why or why not? Be specific.

POWERPOINT PRESENTATION OF PLOT---110 points total

*Minimum of 1 slide per chapter; total number of slides to equal 12 including a title and conclusion slide.

Slide 1: Title slide (4 points)

1. title of book
2. author of book
3. title of your presentation
4. student's name

Slides 2-11 (100 points total)

1. Title: chapter title or number
2. Bulleted list: include events that take place in that chapter...must be chronologically done. Keep sentences short. You will explain it in more detail as you present.
3. Graphic: include picture(s) on each slide that connect with what is happening in the story. Must be relevant!

Slide 12: Conclusion Slide (6 points total)

1. Title: Slide must have a title... you decide what it is
2. Rating: Did you like the book? Why or why not? Be specific.

POWERPOINT PRESENTATION BOOK ANALYSIS—110 points total

* Twelve slides total.

Slide 1: Title slide (4 points)

1. title of book
2. author of book
3. title of presentation
4. student's name

Slide 2: Setting (10 points)

1. Title: the setting of the novel
2. List: Describe the setting. Put as a bulleted list, minimum of 5 descriptions
3. Picture: include a picture that matches what the book describes of the setting

Slides 3-5: Character slides (30 points)

1. Titles: Title the slides appropriately, depending on how you list the characters.
2. List the characters in the book and one main personality trait of each.
3. Include a graphic on each slide that relate

Slides 6-10: Plot slides (50 points)

1. Titles: Each slide has a title that is the chapter(s) that that slide is covering
2. List major events that happen in that portion of the book
3. Include a graphic that is connected to the events

Slide 11: Theme (10 points)

1. Title
2. Write a sentence or two that tells what the author wants the reader to understand about life. THIS IS NOT PLOT, but what is the point of the story?
3. Include a picture that connects with what you believe is the theme of the novel.

Slide 12: Conclusion Slide (6 points total)

1. Title: Slide must have a title... you decide what it is
2. Rating: Did you like the book? Why or why not? Be specific.

PODCAST—110 points

*Record yourself as a newscaster covering the story.

1. Should be at least 10 minutes.
2. Should have an introduction including the newscaster's name and station identification.
3. Should recount the events of the novel in chronological order.
4. Should be presented as a news story.
5. Should include a conclusion, including the newscaster's name and station identification.
6. Should have a "commentary" on the story sharing your feelings on the story. Do you agree/disagree with characters' decisions? What should/shouldn't have been done? How does it affect the listeners of the station or community?
